Kuwait Investment Authority presents job vacancies for Kuwaiti Nationals to work at the World Bank for two years. The positions will be located at the World Bank Office in Washington D.C.

1- Energy Specialist (Energy & Extractives Global Practice (GEEDR)/MNA Region) (TOR # 017-2017).

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- 1. Minimum master's degree in business, engineering, economics or related field.
- 2. Minimum 5 years of experience working with multilateral financial institution, International institutions or bilateral donors dealing with energy sector strategic and policy issues as well as participating or leading operational and analytic work.
- 3. A track record of team work and ability to produce high-quality policy and project related written outputs with limited supervision. Strong research and analytical skills with demonstrated ability to deliver high caliber analytical work will be a distinct advantage.
- 4. Demonstrated local and/or regional operational experience, including experience in preparing and implementing energy projects and analytical work in areas such as energy efficiency and renewable energy; preparation of investment projects in power generation; energy sector reforms; and tariff calculation and reforms.
- 5. Excellent interpersonal skills and proven ability to build strong partnerships with clients and colleagues across units and departmental boundaries in a multi-cultural environment with virtual teams located in different countries.
- 6. Demonstrated track record of building and maintaining strong relationships with senior policy makers and donor counterparts.
- 7. Proficiency in spoken and written English and Arabic are essential.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- 2. Master's degree in a subject relating to land administration, territorial development, land economics, land law, land surveying or information technology.
- 3. At least 5 years of relevant work experience, preferably in a Government institution, a development institution, or an International Non-Governmental Organization.
- 4. Ability to work flexibly on a range of assignments, and adjust to and prioritize a variety of complex evolving tasks.

- 6. Understanding of land management issues in Kuwait and land tenure challenges globally is a plus;
