Job Vacancies for Kuwaiti Nationals At The World Bank - (MID - CAREER LEVEL)

Kuwait Investment Authority presents the available job vacancies for Kuwaiti Nationals to work at the World Bank for two years. The positions will be located at the World Bank Office in Washington D.C.

1- Financial Management Specialist - Governance Standards Codes and Systems Global Unit (GGOSC/GGEVP) (TOR # 030-2018).

SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Master's degree in a relevant discipline (e.g. accounting, business administration, finance, economics, etc.).
2. Minimum of five years of relevant experience working on financial management and/or public sector in operations, public finance and corporate financial reporting issues in an operational context for government and development agencies.
3. Extensive experience in PFM reforms and PFM analytical work, including the PEFA Performance Measurement Framework, and detailed knowledge of the various dimensions of the PFM cycle (budget formulation, execution, controls, accounting and reporting, auditing and oversight of public finances).
4. Demonstrated analytic and operational skills in PFM and practical experience working on the design and delivery of projects and/or studies on areas key to public sector reforms.
5. Demonstrated understanding of the individual international financial reporting standards for the public and private sectors or comparable national standards, the latest trends in corporate financial reporting, and the principles and processes applied to standards development.
6. Proactive and action-oriented, ability to anticipate, coordinate, and prioritize activities.
7. High degree of tact, sensitivity and discretion in dealing with internal and external clients, staff, and managers at all levels, and in handling confidential and sensitive information.
8. Outstanding interpersonal skills, track record of working effectively in a multicultural team environment and ability to build effective working relations with counterparts in Government, donor agencies, private sector representatives and World Bank colleagues.
9. Excellent written and verbal communication skills in English; written, verbal communication and reading skills in French is essential.
10. Ability to work independently and under pressure.
